The following awards will be presented to historical societies: the Walter L. Brown Award for the Best County or Local Journal, which carries a \$100 prize and certificate; Honorable Mention as runner-up for best county or local historical publication (which carries a certificate); the Award for the Best Use of Graphics in a journal (certificate); and the award for Best Newsletter (certificate).

The AHA also recognizes the many excellent articles published by offering awards to individual authors. These awards include the Walter L. Brown Award for the Best Article in a County or Local Journal, which carries a \$100 prize and certificate, and the following which are awarded with a certificate: the Award for the Best Biography, Autobiography, or Memoir; the Award for the Best Family History; the Award for Best Church History; the Award for Best Community History; the Award for Best School History; the Award for Best Business History; and the Award for Best Edited Document.

The award ceremony will be April 10, 2026 in Monticello, AR.

HOW TO SUBMIT

To be considered, interested societies should submit **three complete sets** of the volume of its journal completed in 2025, as well as any newsletters published. A volume may consist of a single annual publication, two semi-annual publications, four quarterly issues, etc. Entries will be judged on the basis of format, historical content, writing style, and editing.
